What will you learn about?

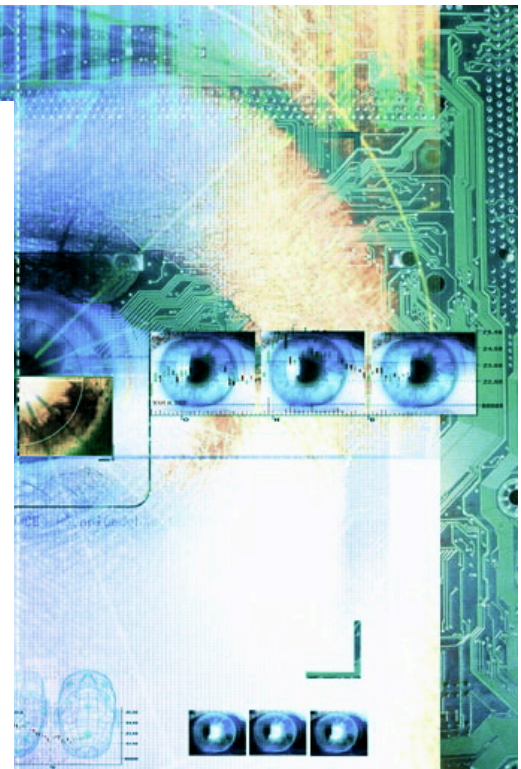
