

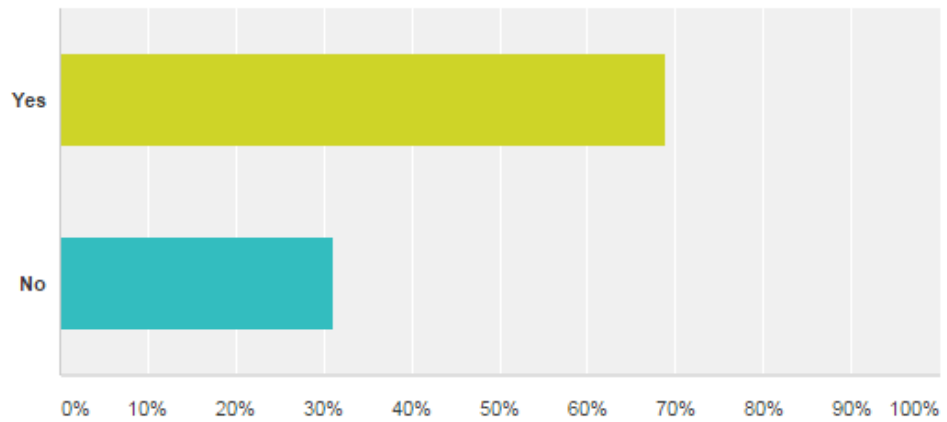

Do you have a library facility within the school of architecture building?

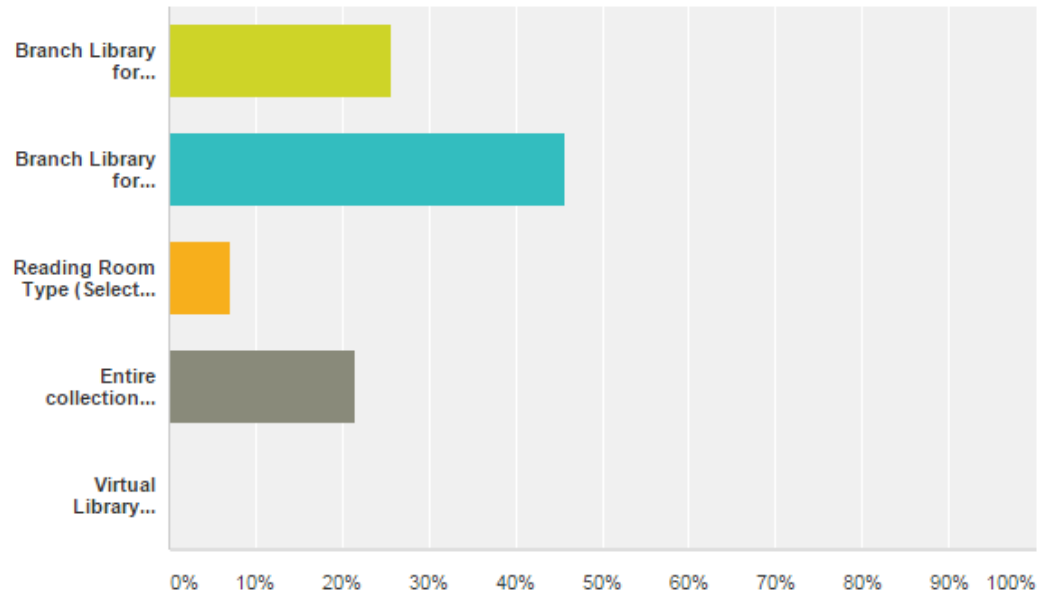

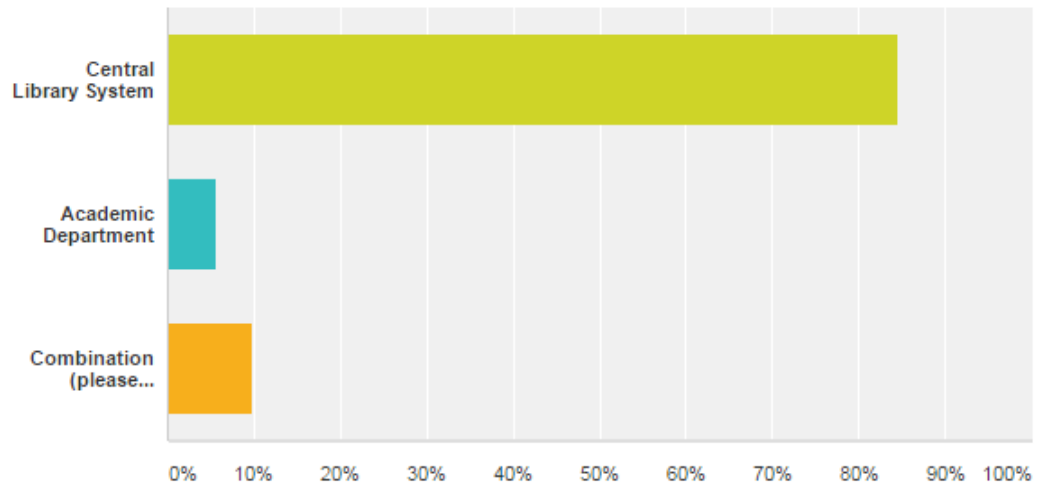

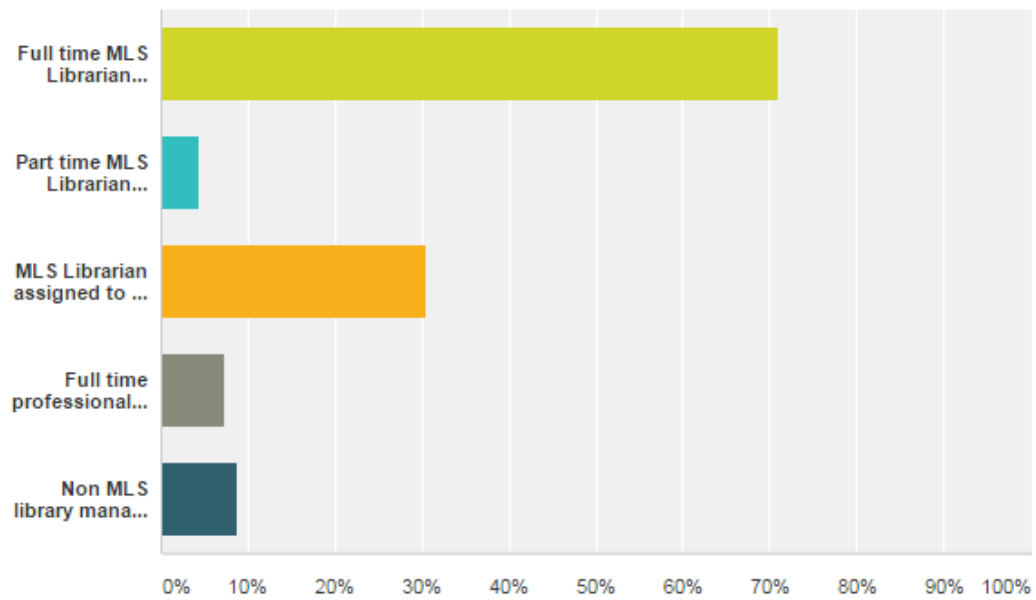

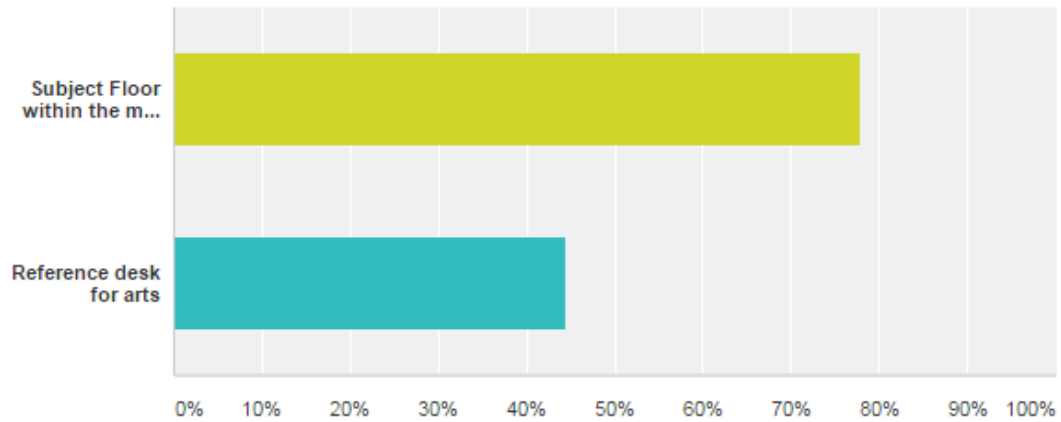

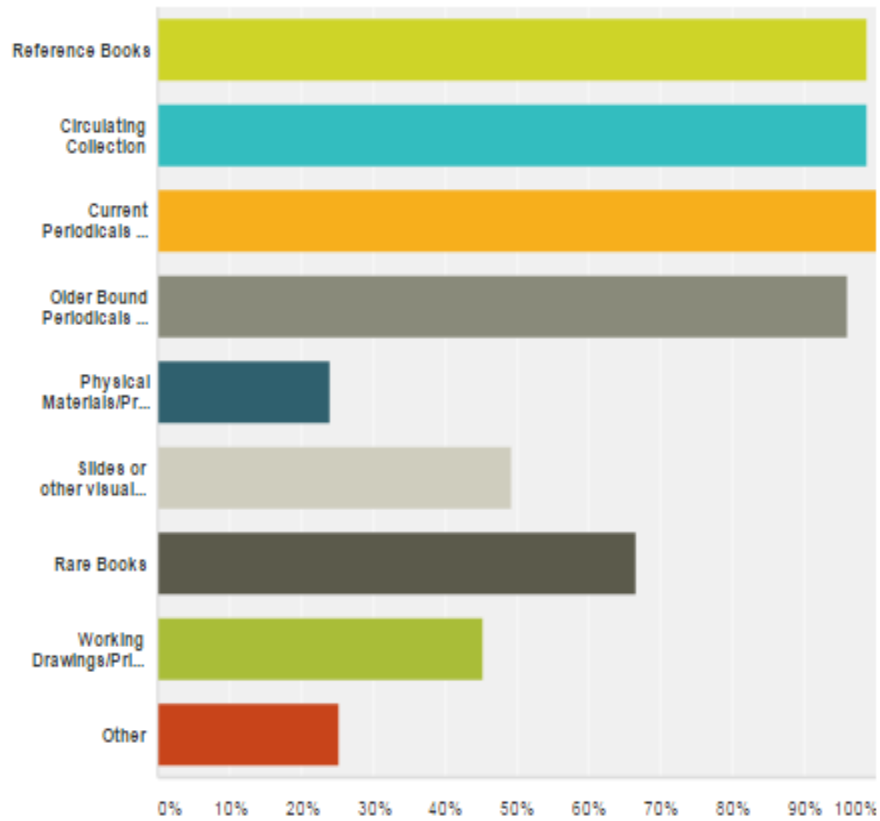

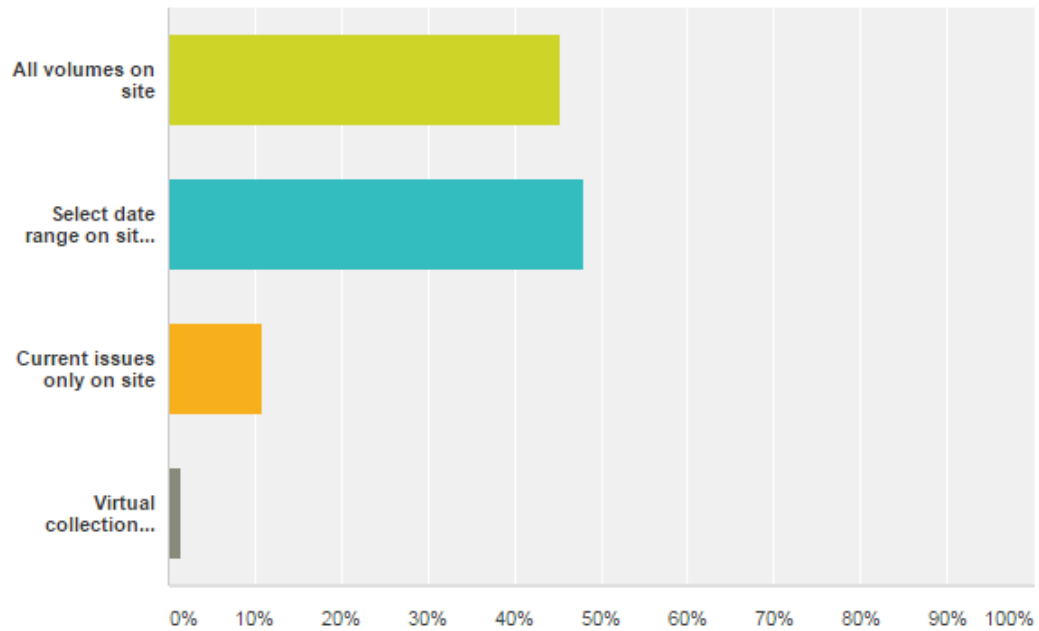

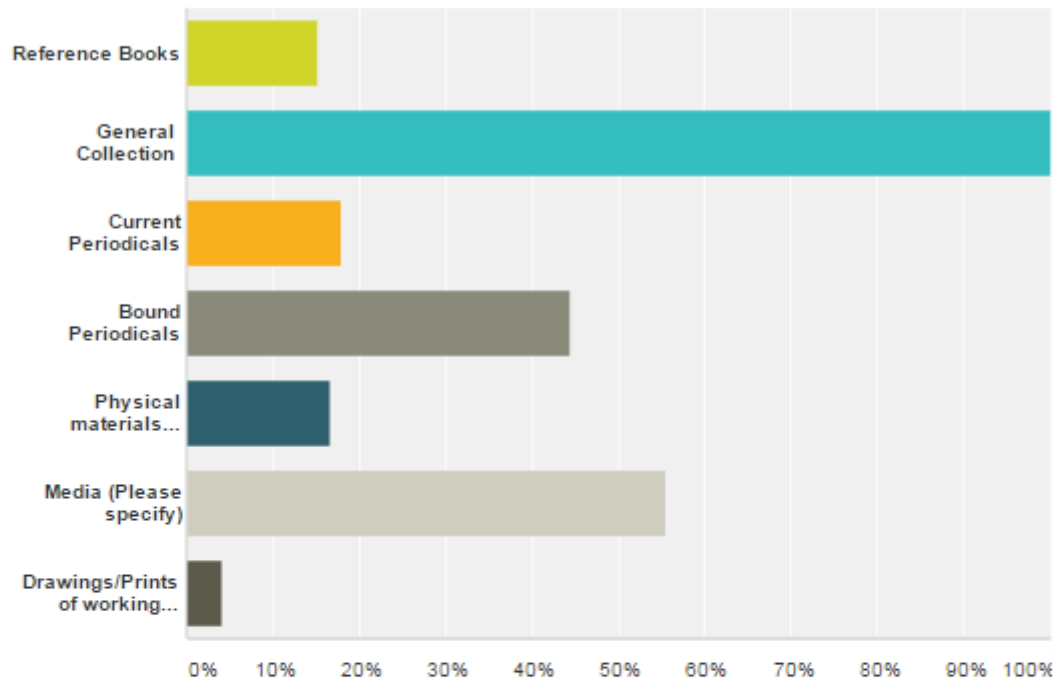

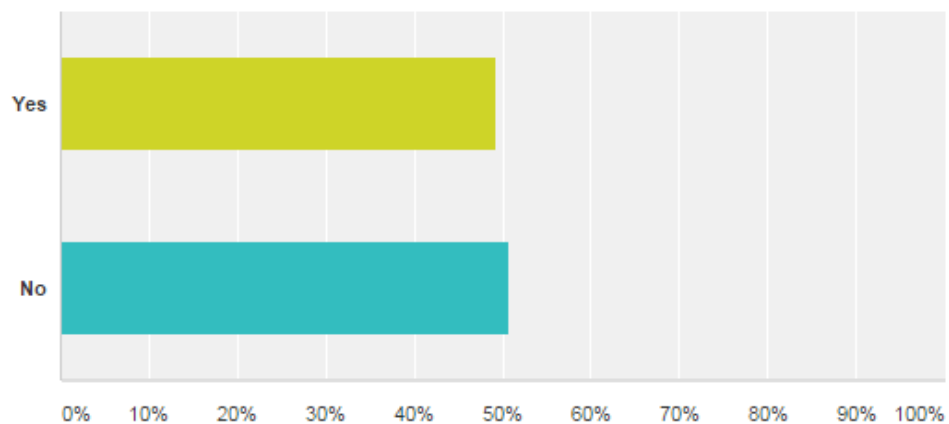

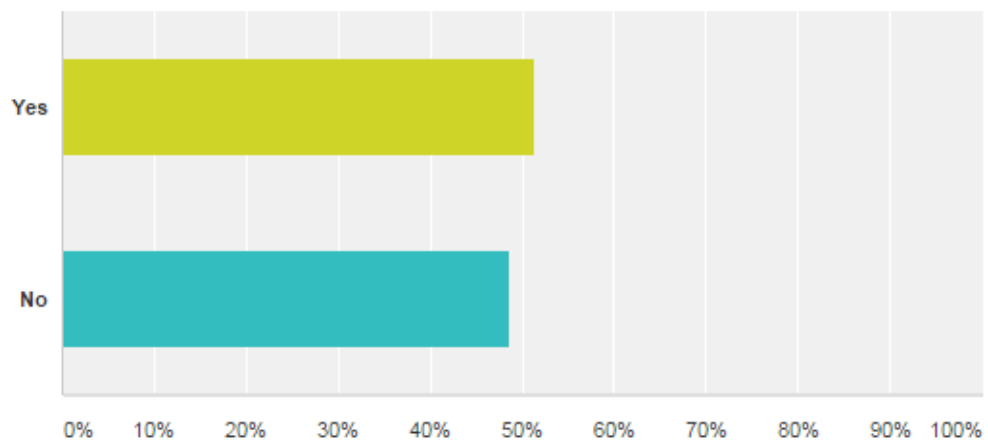

Response Summaries

Question 2 Response Summary:

Some of the responses say that the library is located within a broader fine arts library, often combined with other subject disciplines. Other responses say that they are separated and have their own branch library.

Question 3 Response Summary:

Most major costs (books, salaries) are funded by the Central Library. Some of the minor costs (office supplies, computers) are funded by School of Architecture or endowments.

Question 4 Response Summary:

Many libraries have additional student workers. Most libraries have more than one librarian, sometimes being committed to more than just architecture.

Question 5 Response Summary:

Most have a unit within the main library, with some being in a separate building outside the library.

Question 6 Response Summary:

Many libraries contain some type of DVD collection and VHS tapes. Some libraries maintain a thesis collection.

Question 7 Response Summary:

Some libraries keep issues of periodicals on site for the past 5-10 years. Some libraries put their pre 1975 collections offsite. There is generally some number of periodicals that are electronic.

Question 8 Response Summary:

Most libraries have DVDs that circulate with the occasional VHS collection also kept.

Question 9 Response Summary:

Most responses deal with lack of shelf space, causing talks of moving some part of the collection to the main library or off site.

Most responses say that they have hired a GIS librarian in the past 5 to 10 years.
