 - a) <http://www.palci.org/palci-services/>
 - b) “A well-known, highly-regarded service, E-ZBorrow sends requests to lending libraries automatically without involving library staff. The materials are then delivered to the home library of the requestor in 3-5 business days through the Interlibrary Delivery Service of Pennsylvania.”
 - c) 95% fill rate? Wow.
- 8) OCLC
 - a) Perhaps we as art libraries can put together a list of issues we have with OCLC
 - i) Funding models
 - ii) Libraries who cannot OCLC products.
 - b) Interesting tidbit: OCLC charges borrowers \$.25 per borrow for use of IFM

 - iii) How many ILLs/year?
