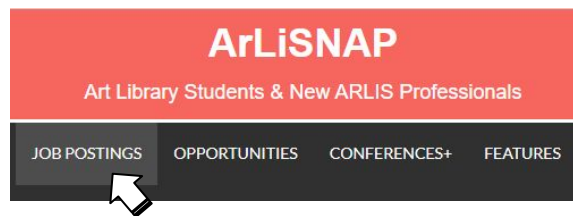


- Collaborative conference organized by our Conference Planning Liaison, Lauren Haberstock, and VREPS representatives

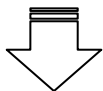
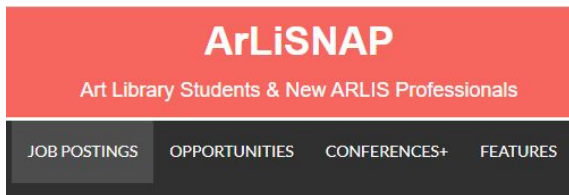

- Publishes entries for the ArLiSNAP blog

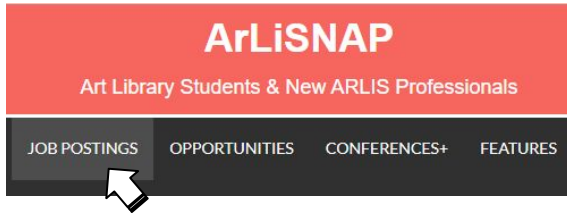

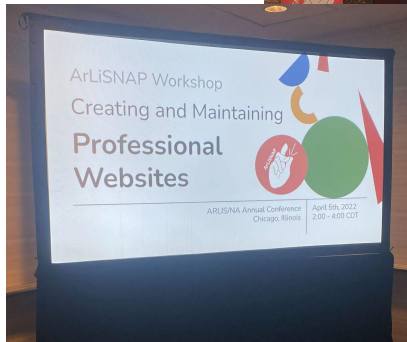
Job Postings/Professional Development Opportunities Liaison

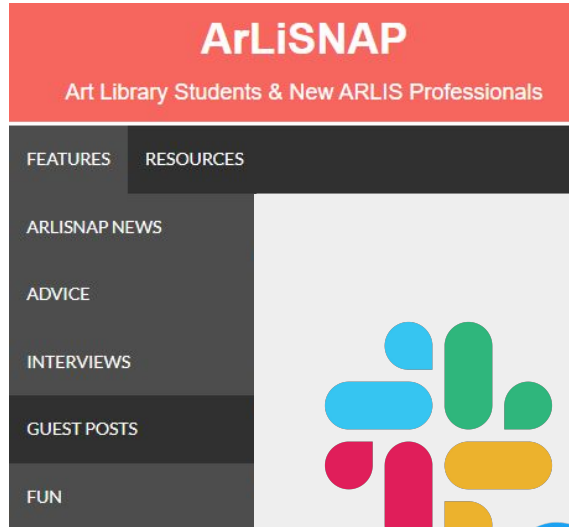
Upcoming Plans
